The campsite is 1.5-2 hours from Oslo Airport, Gardermoen.

The camp's theme this year will be "The Jubilee Week" where the camp's history over 70 years will be covered and there will be many exciting topics, and at the same time there will also be activities that fit the theme!

At the camp, there will be many fun, problem-solving and self-mastery-promoting activities from morning to night!

Each Nordic country can send a maximum of 10 participants aged 18–30, as well as 1 leader. The camp is for deaf and hearing-impaired youth who use sign language.
